## Dear parent/guardian

I hope that you and your family are well and safe. We look forward to welcoming our children back next week (and I am convinced you are exceptionally happy about that) and please read the copy of the email sent out on the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for details to how we will manage our staggered start. It have attached it at the bottom of this correspondence.

A special plea from our side, we relaxed our appearance rules during last year due to all the Covid-19 restrictions. However, we want a good start to the year. Please ensure that your child has the correct uniform and that their hair is acceptable. You will instinctively know whether it is acceptable. We want to focus on academics and ensuring that your child is successful this year despite the trying conditions we are operating under. Please support us in this matter. You too want to be proud of the school your child is associated with.

Also, as with any organization, we have operating costs. Besides the 21 school governing body employees we have, we also have the normal running cost of electricity and water etc. Therefore we are dependent on you to pay your school fees so that we can better develop the school and the educational outcomes for your child.

I am therefore writing to you to inform you of the following:

## School Fee account is for the full 2021 academic year.

Parents have the option to pay it in 11 equal payments of R1 820 from January to November

OR

In full by 28 February 2021 to receive a discount of R1 000.

Extra account is payable no later than 28 February 2021 and includes the following:

Gr 8 - 9 for EMS workbook - R60

GR 8 – 9 for Geography workbooks – R60

(This is not supplied by the department and it is used to cover our printing costs)

GR 10 - 12 learners who take CAT - R330

GR10 - 12 learners who take Consumer Studies - R230

GR10 – 12 learners will **only receive Textbooks for each Additional Subject** once R400 has been paid per Additional Subject.

2021 Textbooks will only be issued when:

- i. All 2020 Textbooks have been handed in AND
- ii. Lost Textbooks have been paid for in 2020 at R240 per book
- iii. Any 2020 books received back in 2021 will be considered as Lost Textbooks and will carry a cost of R250 per book.
- iv. Late 2021 Textbooks handed in after the due date, during 2021, will be levied at R30 per book

Please understand that we are in a partnership and that we need to support each other, now more than ever.
