The Further Education and Training (FET) was implemented at all schools in 2006. The following FOUR subjects are fundamental subjects and must be taken by all students in grades 10 - 12 at Bosmansdam High School:

*ART CENTRE AND MUSIC CENTRE

Art is offered at the Tygerberg Art Centre in Parow after school hours. Parents are responsible for the transport of pupils to and from the Art Centre. Application to the Art Centre must be done at the Art Centre. Students may choose between Design and Visual Arts as subjects and the subject are WCED accredited. COMPUTER CENTRE

The school has three modern computer centres with E-mail and internet facilities which are accessible to all pupils.

Bosmansdam is a Google Suite School for Education. G-suite is a suite of cloud computing productivity and collaboration software tools offered by GOOGLE. Every learner has access to Google's popular web applications including Gmail, Google Drive (unlimited cloud storage), Google Classroom, Google Calendar and Google Docs.

EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGIST

Our school offers the services of an educational psychologist who is available to assist with learning and other difficulties. Melissa Ridgway is requested with Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA-PS0121479).

LEARNER SUPPORT

Our school offers the services of Learner Support Educator from the Metro North Education District namely Deidre McGregor.

Any learners at risk failing to meet the Home Language requirements, will be attending learner support lessons at school. These learners will be supported in allocated times with the normal school hours.

Most learners only have to follow the intervention programme for one year in order to catch up to their fellow learners. This programme uses scaffolding to help the learner binge the gap between what they can do, and what they are expected to know and do, thus supporting them in their endeavour to meet the Home Language requirements.

FINANCE

SCHOOL FEES

Compulsory school fees are payable in 11 instalments from January to November of each year. The Governing Body will determine the amount annually, but the increase is generally below the annual inflation rate. The present school fees are R21 020 per annum. Grade 8 parents are encouraged to complete a Debit Order form at the Finance Office. Debit orders run from February to December.

A separate account of R120 (Grade 8 2022) is payable by 28 February, for the present EMS and Geography workbooks for 2022. Bosmansdam High School bank account details: Absa Account No: 390391218 Branch code: 632005 Reference: Learners initials, surname & grade.

Grade 7 learners who are head prefects at Wolraad Woltemade or Bosmansdam Primary School will receive a 50 % discount on their school fees until they are in matric. Learners with an average of 80% or above in grade 7 in Wolraad Woltemade or Bosmansdam Primary School will also receive 50% discount on school fees for their first year in Grade 8. All learners with an 85% average at the end of an academic year at Bosmansdam High School, will receive 50% discount on School Fees in the following year.

For enrolment to our school you must complete and/or submit the following:

- 6. Transfer certificate (at the end of the year)

- 8. Copies of ID document of both biological parents/guardians
- 9. Proof of address

Online applications open on the 26th of February 2021 and close on 26th of March 2021. All hard copy applications **MUST** be handed in by Monday, **26th March 2021** at the school secretary.

Please ensure that all information is completed as comprehensively as possible. Parents must confirm acceptance by 25th June 2021. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

GENERAL

More than 90% of our students who enrol in grade 8, will leave in grade 12 with a matric certificate; a throughput rate that we are proud of.

We use the data, received annually from our parent surveys, to further improve our school. (Self-School Evaluation-SSE) Proof that the feedback received from our parents and students are indeed effective was provided in the annual Whole School Evaluation (WSE) that was conducted in 2016 at our school by WCED officials. Bosmansdam High School scored a 4 out of a possible 5 (80%), a score attained by very few schools. An extract from the report reads as follow:
