Should any monthly instalment be outstanding by the due date the full annual school fees will become due and payable as well as all costs incurred. The school can record the non-performance on school fee obligation to a credit bureau and take legal action against such non-performance.

Parents will receive two separate accounts every month. One account is for School Fees, the other for Additional Costs including Printing handouts, CAT consumables & Consumer Studies ingredients & Late or Lost Books & Extra Subjects.

TEXTBOOKS

2023 Textbooks will only be issued when: (i.) All 2022 Textbooks have been handed in AND (ii.) Lost Textbooks have been paid for at R260 per book. (end of 2023 this will be R270 per book) (iii.) Any books received back in 2023 will be considered as Lost Textbooks, and will carry a cost of R270 per book. Late textbooks handed in after the due date, during 2023, will be levied at R50 per book (during 2022 this is R40) and is payable no later than the last shool-day of 2023.

SCHOOL FEE REDUCTION WHERE APPLICABLE (applicable to School Fees only)

Before applying, please consider: 2022 loss in school fee income is over R6 500 000 as the Education Department grant only re-imburses the school for less than 6% of Subsidies granted to parents.

Parents who meet the criteria as prescribed in Section 39 of the SA Schools' Act 1996, as amended, are entitled to apply for a reduction in monthly school fees. Application forms CAN only be requested via email sent to deliseb@bosmansdam.co.za from 24 January 2023. Parents/guardians must print it and return the fully completed forms with all the requested documentation to the Finance Office not later than <u>8 February 2023</u>. Completed forms cannot be sent via email. These forms will then be submitted to the Governing Body. Full school fees are payable until the outcome of subsidy application is communicated to the parents. Please note that the combined gross income of both biological parents is considered in assessing a parent's financial standing. The law requires you to re-apply every year. It is only by submitting the relevant forms and supporting documentation that you are legally allowed to be granted a rebate. Late applications will only qualify from date of receipt and incomplete applications will not be accepted or considered. The determined amount is payable in equal monthly instalments. Debit order forms can be signed at the Finance Office. This debit order will not qualify for the 50% deduction in December 2023. Parents of foster learners are granted full exemption of school fees only. Parents are obliged to hand in legal documents as proof of foster care.
