## HOW I AM EXPECTED TO BEHAVE IN CLASS, AND WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T !!!!!

The basic rule is very easy to understand .... i.e. **RESPECT OTHERS** !! , including the teacher and your fellow students. In other words take the needs of others into account before drawing attention to yourself.

A respectful student/person is expected to behave as follows:

- 1. Arrive at the class on time, and line up quietly behind each other.
- 2. Upon entering the classroom, stand next to your desk and return the greeting of the teacher. Do not chat to your friends, that can be done at break.
- 3. When asked to by the teacher, sit down and immediately take out your work/homework/books.
- 4. Do not communicate with others.
- 5. Obey the teacher's instructions.
- 6. Write down instructions if necessary, write down homework etc.
- 7. Raise your hand to ask any relevant question and wait for the teacher to respond.
- 8. Remain seated in your desk; do not move about the classroom.
- 9. At the end of the lesson, wait for the teacher to dismiss you row by row. Remain seated while this happens.

- 1. You will receive a warning from the teacher. Respond with respect, do **NOT** backchat or become rude and cheeky.
- 2. If you continue to misbehave, the teacher will give you a demerit, which is later entered onto your record on the school computer system.
- 3. If you continue for a third time, you will be sent out of the classroom, with your case, to the **TIME-OUT** room, where a teacher on duty will phone your parents and tell them you were sent out of class. This is also entered on the school computer system.
- 4. If this pattern continues, you will receive Detentions, or Saturday detentions or you will eventually be referred to the **TRIBUNAL**, who will consider suspension or expulsion.
