

**RESOLUTIONS OF THE BUDGET MEETING
WITH PARENTS TO BE HELD ON 8 OCTOBER 2019
AT BOSMANSDAM HIGH SCHOOL
19h00**

RESOLUTION ADOPTED AND APPROVED:

1. SCHOOL FEES

I propose that:

- a) The school will be a fee paying school and school fees have been determined and levied in accordance with the provisions of Section 38 and 39(1) of the South African Schools Act.
- b) The school fees are determined in terms of the above Act and are in relation or participation of the learner in any of the school programme as defined and approved by the parents.
- c) All other programmes or activities as defined and approved are not part of the school programme, are voluntary and carry an additional cost.
- d) School fees for 2020 determined and levied to be R19 700 for GR8 learners (which includes the R1 000 Compulsory 1st Installment payable on admission) and R18 700 per learner for GR9 to GR12.
- e) School fees are payable in 11 equal instalments of R1 700 per month, commencing on the 1st January 2020 and ending the 1st November 2020

2. SCHOOL FEE PAYMENT PLAN

I propose that:

- a) School fees payable in full by 31 December 2019, in which case a discount of R1 700 will be granted.
- b) School fees payable: R1 700 by 1 January 2020 and 1 February 2020 and the balance in full by 29 February 2020, in which case a discount of R1 000 will be granted.

- c) Should any monthly instalment be outstanding by the due date the full annual school fees will become due and payable as well as all costs incurred.
- d) A parent's school fee debt (full or to the extent that he has been exempted) is a statutory obligation and thus takes priority over other voluntary debts as listed under voluntary programmes. Money received will first be allocated to arrear school fees.
- e) The school can record the non- performance on school fee obligation to a credit bureau and take legal action against such non-performance.
- f) The school has the right to verify all information supplied to them.

3. EXEMPTIONS

I propose that:

- a) All parents shall be obligated to pay school fees in terms of section 40 of the South African Schools act, unless they have been granted exemption from the payment of school fees. The criteria for the total, partial or conditional exemption of parents, who are unable to pay compulsory school fees, be determined in accordance with the criteria set out in *The Exemption of Parents from School Fees Regulations* (as amended in Government Gazette 39392 of 17 November, 2006)
The determined amount is payable in equal monthly instalments.
- b) Parents of foster learners are granted full exemption of school fees only. Parents are obliged to hand in legal documents as proof of foster care.

I propose that:

7. ADDITIONAL COSTS:

I propose that:

- a) CAT consumables for 2020 determined and levied to be R320 for GR10 to GR12 learners payable no later than 29 February 2020.
- b) Consumer Studies ingredients for 2020 determined and levied to be R220 for GR10 to GR12 learners payable no later than 29 February 2020.
- c) EMS workbook for 2020 determined and levied to be R60 for GR8 and GR9 learners payable no later than 29 February 2020.
- d) Geography workbook for 2020 determined and levied to be R60 for GR8 and GR9 learners payable no later than 29 February 2020.
- e) 2020 Textbooks will only be issued when:
 - i. All 2019 Text Books have been handed in AND
 - ii. Lost Textbooks have been paid for at R240 per book.

- iii. Any books received back in 2021 will be considered as Lost Textbooks, and will carry a cost of R240 per book.
- f) Late Textbooks, handed in after the due date, during 2020, determined and levied to be R20 for GR8 to GR12 learners payable no later than last school-day of 2020.
